This Trust Deed is made on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2016 at Mumbai, between (1) Mr. RAVINDRA BALASO JADHAV, Age about 28 years, adult, Indian Inhabitant of Mumbai occupation Student, residing at Room No-32, Rawji Sojpal Chawl No-13, T. Road, Sewree (W), Mumbai-400015. hereinafter referred to as the "THE SETTLER " of the first part, AND hereinafter to as "THE MANAGING TRUSTEE" 2) Mr. DAYANAND SHRIRAM KUBAL, Age about 35 years, Occupation Service, Trustee, residing at 141, Philips Sutari Chawl, S. V, Road, Old Khar (West), Mumbai-400052. 3) Mr. SHANKAR SHIVAJI GHADAGE age about 28 Years, Occupation Service, Trustee residing at 2, Ground Floor, E, Raoji Sojpal Chawl, Sakharam Lanjekar Marg, Golanji Hill, Sewree, Mumbai-400015. 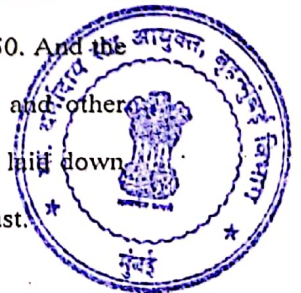
Whereas the Settler is absolutely and sufficiently entitled to and possessed of the sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only), AND WHEREAS the Settler is desirous of settling a Charitable Trust wholly of the purpose of Charity of the said sum of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) UPON TRUST with and subject to the power and provision hereafter, declared, contained, provided and in the manner hereinafter appearing in the Scheme.

AND WHEREAS the parties of the second part on being requested by the Settler to act and become the trustees of this Trust as testified their being parties to and executing the Deed of Trust.

And whereas the Mr. Ravindra Balaso Jadhav has agreed to become the Managing trustee during his lifetime and hold the said sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) s MANAGING TRUSTEE UPON TRUST.

AND WHEREAS the said sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) in anticipation of this Deed of Trust has been already transferred paid, and handed over to the trustees before execution of this Deed of Trust.

AND NOT THIS DEED WITNESS that for the purpose of effectuating the said desire of the Settler, the Settler has irrevocable transferred the said sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) to the trustees. The transfer whereof the trustees do and each of them doth, hereby admit and acknowledge which is held by the trustees upon trust which they shall with on practicably dispatch, invest the aforesaid sum in the Scheduled Bank, Co-Operative Bank & Nationalized Bank or in public securities as defined under section 2 (12) of the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950. And the trustees shall hold the aforesaid sum as trust fund of the trust and other accretion thereto subject to and in conformity with the provisions laid down hereinafter for the better management and administration of the Trust.

1] NAME OF THE TRUST:

The name of the Trust shall be "HEALTH N CARE FOUNDATION".

2] REGISTERED ADDRESS OF THE TRUST:

3] PROPERTY OF THE TRUST

The properties of the trust shall consist of all the immovable and movable properties and shall be maintained in a separate "A" and "B" Registers. All these properties and new accretion thereto acquisition and donations received thereafter shall be called the "TRUST PROPERTIES".

4] VESTING THE TRUST PROPERTY:

The trust property shall be vested in the Trustee for the time being under this Scheme and shall be administered and managed by them subject to and in conformity with the provisions of this Deed.

5] OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

1. To create unity, brotherhood amongst the General Public.
2. To promote welfare, social, cultural, charitable, health, education, humanitarian and relief activities that will protect, safeguard, improve the quality of poor's and raise the standard of human life, irrespective of caste, color, sex or religion.
3. To carry out any activities with the intention of help and collaborate in establishing and running medical centers, old age homes, Ashrams, rehabilitation, institutions for the destitute, vocational training centers for the handicapped, poor's and needy.
4. To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally reared persons and to provide them education, food, clothing etc. To establish, run, support, maintain and manage hospital, diagnostic center, pathology, ultrasound, x-ray and dispensaries for poor's.
5. To give scholarship, free ships and educational help such as school uniforms, school books, notebooks & stationery to the needy and deserving students without making distinction of caste and creed.

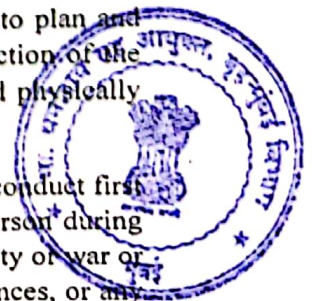

6. To provide free medical camp such as blood donation camp, heart checkup, eye checkup, and complete body checkup etc for poor in urban and rural area. To give free medicine, injection and other medical help to Cancer patients, Aids patients and T.B. patients etc. To provide free ambulance service to the poor and deserving people.
7. To undertake, carry out promote and sponsor rural development including any program for promoting the social economic welfare of or the uplift of public in any area and to incur any expenditure on any program of rural development and to assist execution and promotion thereof either directly or through any independent agency, or in any other manner as provide under section 35-CC & 35 CCA of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
8. To provide relief to the people who are affected by natural calamities.
9. To implement the scheme of Government, Semi Government, Municipal Corporation about Self employment to the needy women, to establish Vocational Training programs for the needy and poor women.
10. To create various activities to improve the people's standard of living related to their basic needs, social problems and encourage social, economical, cultural, educational, Physical, Intellectual activities, Organize sports camps, competition training classes, to increase interest in various National /International sports among youths, make available the sports elements to the sportsman/ sportswomen and organize various competitions and distribute prizes.
11. To try to keep area clean. To keep a balance in environment and adopt the gardens and plantation. For plantation and equilibrium of environment the areas wherever it is possible to acquire cultivated or non cultivated lands from owner or government in order to make it green zone or any other environment free projects for the preservation and equilibrium of the environment.
12. To provide ancillary charitable services to the general public and needy, irrespective of caste, creed, race, color, sex or religion.
13. To establish temporary / permanent and /or mobile centers of education in the field of literacy, self awareness Development, Self Employment, conservation of Natural Resource, Optimum utilization of water, a forestation and environment. To appoint Sub - Committees to plan and implement programmes beneficial to a particular weaker section of the society like woman, children, un-employed youths, aged and physically challenged persons.
14. To provide first aid in medical and surgical emergencies. To conduct first aid classes, grant medical help to the poor and deserving person during epidemic, famine, flood, earthquake or any unforeseen calamity or war or warlike operation, riots, civil commotion and similar occurrences, or any other time of need.

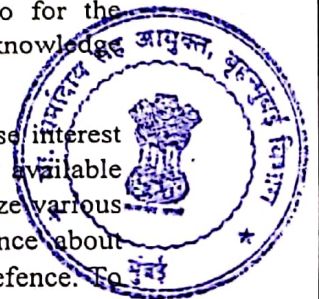

15. To co-operate, promote and render assistance to organizations, institutions having similar object and purpose, for better and mutual comprehension and help them in our/ their growth and stability.
16. To establish , run, support and grant aid or other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research and other institutions of the like nature in India, for use of the poor students for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general and poor.
17. To establish, maintain and run studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books, stipends, medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, color, race, creed or sex to poor and needy. To establish, run, and provide help to run such Library, and Reading Room.
18. Providing for or contributing to education and scientific research and development. To encourage medical education, arrange medical seminars, physical fitness education workshops and conferences for specific diseases, medical research and family planning.
19. To support the Children and young people to meet their Emotional, Social and Health needs to grow up as responsible citizens through provision of appropriate education, knowledge and services.
20. To promote environmental awareness and safeguards the global environment and to that end carry on such activities as may be necessary.
21. To establish, take over, run maintain a center or centers for Senior Citizen or retirement's homes or old people homes or shelter for street children with facilities such as, health care nutrition, recreation etc. as may be necessary.
22. To open, conduct, maintain and manage educational institutions such as Kinder Garden, Pre-primary, Primary & Secondary Schools , Junior and Senior Colleges of all faculty, Technical, D. Ed. B.Ed., I.T.I. & Ayurvedic, Polytechnic Colleges, Engineering colleges, Medical Colleges, Laboratories, Libraries, reading room, hostel, Boarding, Community Hall etc. to Establish, run, support and grant aid or other assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms & other universities, Laboratories, research and other institutions of the like nature in India, for use of the students and staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general, poor and needy.
23. Organize sports camps, competition training classes, to increase interest in various National /International sports among youths, make available the sports elements to the sportsman/ sportswomen and organize various competitions and distribute prizes. To aware about importance about physical health arrange the campaign for meditation and self defence. 25. To establish, set-up, run a modern, well equipped medical hospital & research center, blood bank and maintain properly which is available for the needy rural, poor citizen in the society. In such hospital to give better medical treatment in lowest prices or free of cost. To give the ambulance facility for needy people.
26. To set-up, run and maintain properly the schools and hostels for the deaf, dumb and mentally disable children / people in the society.
27. The Trust will not carry out any activities with the intention of earning profit and will perform with charitable purpose only.
28. To co-operate, promote and render assistance to organizations, institutions having similar object and purpose, for better and mutual comprehension and help them in our/ their growth and stability.

**PROVIDED THAT** the trust shall be an irrevocable public, cultural, educational trust for the benefit of all persons belonging to whatever community irrespective of Caste, Creed, Religion, Nationality, Age or Sex, the Trustees shall stand possessed of the said amount of corpus endowed by the Authors of the trust and such other properties (both movable and immovable) as may be acquired from-time to time by the Trust, by purchase, exchange, grant, allotment, subscription, endowment, donation, contribution, or in any manner to whatsoever (all of which shall be designed as Trust properties) on the Trust herein mentioned.

6] **NUMBER OF TRUSTEES:**

The number of trustees shall not be less than minimum 3 and not more than maximum 7.

7] **MANAGING TRUSTEES:**

The trustees from among themselves select one of them as Managing Trustee and/or Chairman for life time. The first such managing trustee and/or Chairman of this trust for life time shall be Mr. RAVINDRA BALASO JADHAV.

8] **TENURE OF TRUSTEESHIP:**

Present trustees and all subsequent trustees to come after them shall hold office for life. The Surviving or continuing trustees to appoint new Trustees throughout in their absolute discretion in case of vacancies arising due to death, resignation and removal of trustees.

9] QUALIFICATION OF TRUSTEES:  
Any Indian male or female of above 21 years, are having good moral character shall be eligible to become a trustee of this Trust.

- 10] DISQUALIFICATION OF THE TRUSTEESHIP:  
The Trustees of the said Trust shall be disqualified to act as Trustees if.
- a) He/She acts against the interest of the trust and does not abide by the Deed of Trust and Rules and Regulations framed there under.
  - b) He/She commits any acts of malfeasance, misfeasance, misappropriation, Breach of Trust in respect of this Trust.
  - c) He/She convicted of criminal offence involving moral Turpitude or of offence described under the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950.
  - d) He/She is adjudged or declared he or herself insolvent.
  - e) He/She voluntarily resigns or physically and/or mentally becomes incapable to act as Trustees, or of unsound mind. Or if he or she is removed from the trust.

11] FIRST BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TRUST:

- 1. Mr. RAVINDRA BALASO JADHAV
- 2. Mr. DAYANAND SHRIRAM KUBAL
- 3. Mr. SHANKAR SHIVAJI GHADAGE

12] CONSENT OF THE TRUSTEES TO ACT AND THEIR POWER:

Every new Trustee appointed as aforesaid, with his consent previously obtained in writing shall have the same power authorities and discretion And shall in all respect acts as if he/she had been originally appointed under this Deed.

13] For the accomplishment of the Trusts of these presents and without prejudice to the generality of any power hereby law conferred or implied or vested in the Trustee the following powers and authorities are hereby expressly conferred on the Trustee that is to say.

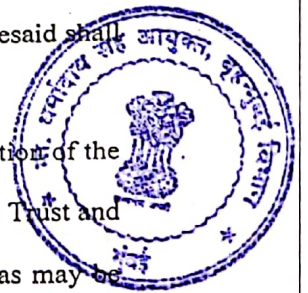

To create the good atmosphere and good reputation goodwill in the society the Board of patrons and the Advisory Board will be appointed by the trustees of the said Trust and will have power to dismiss any one of them or all of them.

- c) To delegate by power or attorney or otherwise to any Trustee of Trustees or other person whomsoever any power implied by law or conferred by statute or varied in the Trustee by these presents and to withdraw or revoke all or any of such powers. The Trustees shall not be held liable or responsible for the acts or defaults or any such person or persons.
- d) To give donation to any public Charitable institution or funds subjects to such terms and conditions as the Trustees may think fit to make but in every such case the Trustees shall make it a condition that the donations shall be spent or applied only for Such welfare purposes as are authorized by this Deed.
- e) To decide all questions arising in the administration of Trust hereof and including all questions relating to the interpretation to these presents or exercise or no exercise of any powers of the trustee and all questions otherwise concerning or touching these present or any clause or thing therein contained or touching or concerning with or arising out of these presents or the operation thereof. The decision of the Managing Trustee on all or any of the matters aforesaid shall be final.
- f) The Trustees shall have power to regulate the administration of the Trust and application of the income so as to occur for the Trust and for any donor to the trust such exemption and/or relief as may be available under any law governing taxation of income or wealth or gifts. The Trustee may for that purpose from time lay down or accept such restriction, condition or limitations as they may think occur may such exemptions or reliefs.

g) The Board of Trustees is empowered to form different Committees to fulfill or to achieve the objectives of the trust as and when required. And those committees can be dissolve or reform whenever need arises by the Board of trustees.

14] AND WHEREAS nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to do any act which may in any way be constructed statutory modifications thereof and all activities of the trust shall be carried out with a view to benefit the public at large, without any profit motive and in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modification thereof. AND WHEREAS the trust is hereby expressly declared to be a public charitable trust and all the provisions of this deed are to be constituted accordingly.

15] **APPLICATION OF INCOME TAX ACT:**

All clauses herein are intended to secure exemption from Income Tax on the Income of contributions and donations to the Trust and any clause or portion of this Deed of Trust which in inconsistent with or repugnant to the sections of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended, substituted or modified from time to time, shall be deemed to be deleted or modified with effect from the date on which the sections to which the clause or part of a clause is repugnant or inconsistent comes into force.

16] **ORDINARY AND SPECIAL MEETINGS:**

The Trustees shall hold at least one meeting every 4 (Four) months and these meeting shall be called the Ordinary Meeting. The Trust may also hold additional meeting and such meeting shall be called Special Meeting. Such Ordinary and Special meetings will be held at such time and place as the Chairman may determine and shall be called by the Chairman.

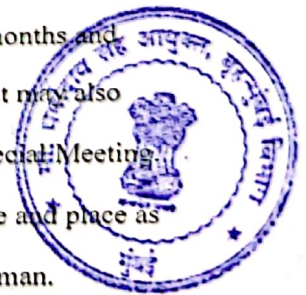
17] **NOTICE OF MEETING OF TRUSTEES:**

Notice in writing of every meeting of the Trustee shall be delivered or sent throw hand delivery or by post to each Trustee at his or her residential Address at least 15 clear days before the date of meeting. Receipt of such notice should be taken in writing.

18] **QUORUM:**  
There shall be a quorum when at least 3/5th Trustees are present at any meetings of the Trustees. If Quorum is not completed, then they said meeting will be adjourned for an hour time, then after an hour they said meeting will be held then and there on the same subjects and the resolution decision taken will be binding to all the members of the trust.

19] **RESOLUTION BY MAJORITY:**  
Every resolution or question submitted to the meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes of the Trustees present at such meeting and voting. On the question each trustee shall one vote, but in the event of equity of votes, the Chairman of such meeting shall have second to casting vote whether or not he has previously voted on the question.

20] **CIRCULAR:**  
Any matter of business of a routine or formal or urgent nature may be determined by circular without meeting of the Trustees provided that it is agreed to unanimously by all Trustees. In case difference of opinion, such question shall be dealt with at the next meeting of the Trustees.

21] **MINUTE BOOK:**  
A minute book shall be kept for this Trust will consist of:  
a) A clear report of the proceedings in the meetings of the Trustees.  
b) All the report of the proceedings in the meeting shall be read over To the Trustees. At the next meeting and when confirmed, shall be signed by the Chairman of such meeting in case of difference of Opinion at the time of confirmation according to the sense of majority of the Trustees presents at such previous meeting.

22] **THE PAYMENT OF MANAGEMENT:**  
On acquisition of immovable properties the Trustees shall out of rents, profits, income and interest of the Trust properties in the first instance pay all a rents, taxes, & assessments. And other necessary outgoing the next place all the proper charges and expenses of and incidental to management and administration the Trust properties as well as the costs of current

repairs to and the upkeep of the immovable proportion belonging to the charity, if any, and thereafter set apart 10% or set apart as Managing Trustee may decided from time to time of the total gross income of reserve fund for the purpose of heavy repairs, renovation of rebuilding of immovable properties, if any belonging to the Trust and pay and apply the balance for the objects of the Trust.

23] REPAIRS TO PROPERTY:

On acquisition of immovable properties the Trustees shall keep the property of the Trust in good conditions. The Trustees shall have power to repairs, modify alter, renovate, develop the immovable property of trust and shall maintain it in good condition.

24] ACCOUNTING YEAR AND ACCOUNTS OF THE TRUST:

Accounting year of the trust will be form 1st April to 31st March.

The Managing trustee shall keep or order to keep and maintain regular accounts of the Trust properties and its income and shall get the accounts, audited as per the provisions of the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950. The Managing Trustee shall order to keep or maintain all books of accounts including:

- 1) Rough Cash Book
- 2) Fair Cash Book
- 3) Ledger
- 4) Donation book entry containing movable full particulars.
- 5) Receipts Book
- 6) Book containing movable and immovable properties containing full particulars and its value.
- 7) Book containing list of investments if any other books as the circumstance demand.

25] BANK ACCOUNTS:

The Settler shall not ordinary keep on hand more than Rs.2000/-. The Managing Trustee shall open Bank accounts in any schedule Bank / Co-operative Bank/ Nationalized Bank in the name of the Trust. The withdrawal can be made by any two signatures in which the signature of the Settler is Mandatory.

26] INVESTMENT:

The Managing Trustee shall invest trust funds and money in accordance to the provisions of Section 35 of the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950, as he may think fit and proper.

27] POWER TO SALE MORTGAGE BORROW ETC.

The Trustees shall have power to borrow money or take loan (whether by way of mortgage, pledge, hypothecation or otherwise) with or without Interest for the purpose of or on behalf of the Trust of which they are trustees only such conditions and limitation as may be imposed by them him in the interest or protection of the trust.

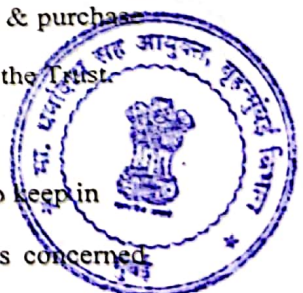
The TRUSTEES SHALL Also have power to transfer, sell & alienate the property with the previous sanctions of the Charity Commissioner.

30] RECEIVING OF DONATIONS:

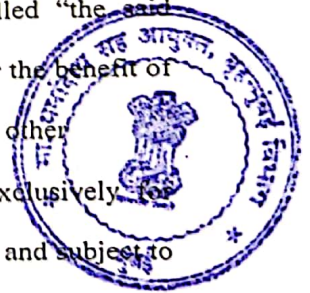
The trustees shall be empowered to receive donations in cash, cheque or in kind, with conditions or without any condition. However, the trustees shall take every care to see that the conditions of donation are in consonance with the objects of the Trust and said donations will be exempted under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

31] SOURCE OF INCOME:

Donation, fees, Gifts, Charity shown, Income from investments, Grants & contributions, Bank interest, Income from cultural programmed, Income on issue of souvenirs, publish books, Audio-Video-CD.etc.

32] TRUST FUND:

The Trustees shall stand and be possessed of said Trust Fund upon Trust to receive the interest, dividends and other income thereof and there out in the first place to reimburse themselves or pay and discharge all the cost, charges and expenses incurred in or about or incidental to administration of execution of any of the trusts or powers of these presents and also all outgoings, taxes, assessments dues and duties and other taxes payable in respect thereof and costs of meetings ordinary repairs of any immovable property, if any, for the time being subject to the trusts of these presents and SUBJECT THERETO upon trust to apply the residue of the said interest, dividend and other income (hereinafter called "the said income"), and at their discretion to apply the Trust Fund for the benefit of the poor and needy persons for education, medical relief and other Charitable purposes. The trust funds shall be applied exclusively for public charitable purpose as per the terms of this Trust deed and subject to such conditions and / or limitations, if any, as May from time to time laid down in the income tax Act, 1961 or any other Act governing the tax action of income as will ensure or make the Trust and its income eligible for exemption from taxation under the Income Tax Act, 1961

or any replacement or re-enactment there of for the purpose of these presents, the expression "charitable purpose" shall have the meaning as is assigned to that expression in the Income Tax act, 1961 and the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 or any statutory modification Of reenactment thereof for the time to time being in force.

The benefits of this Trust Deed shall be given to all persons, without discrimination of caste, creed, community of religion and language. Without Prejudice to the generality of the forgoing objects or purposes, but subject as Aforesaid it is declared that the Trustees shall each year apply the residue of the income of the Trust Fund and at any time and from time to time apply also the Trust Fund or any part or parts of the Trust Fund in or towards anyone or more of the following objects or purposes (which according to law be public charitable objects or purposes) to the exclusion of the other or others of them in such proportion and manner in all respects.

33] POWER TO APPOINT COMMITTEES:

The trustees shall be empowered to appoint and dissolve committees so appointed from time to time for specific purposes. On Ward, Village, Tal. Dist & State level Trust shall open its Branches to fulfilling the objects of the Trust as and when required.

34] POWER TO APPOINT EMPLOYEE:

The Trust shall have power to employ such servants or employees including as they may require for management of Trust on such terms and condition as to on honourium basis or on salary, wages, D.A. etc as it may consider proper time to time and shall have power to dismiss or remove any servant or employees.



35] LIABILITIES OF TRUSTEES:

Every Trustee shall be liable for the acts and deeds expressly to be done by him or her.

37] POWER TO FRAME RULES:

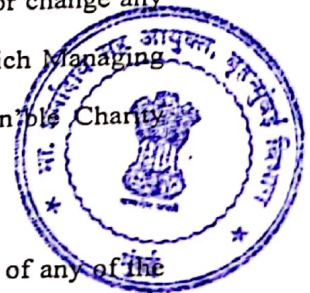
The Board of Trustees shall be empowered to frame Rules in respect of this Trust. The trustees are empowered to frame the Rules and regulations for the branches of the Trust. However it shall be borne in mind by the trustees that the rules framed for the trust are in consonance with the objects and provisions of the Trust Deed and are also inconsonant with the provisions of Bombay Public Act, 1950 and Bombay Public Trust Rules, 1951.

38] AREA OF OPERATION:

The area of operation shall be all over India.

39] TO AMEND THE TRUST DEED OR ANY CLAUSE:

To Board of Trustee will have power to omit, alter, amend or change any clause of the said trust by the 2/3 Majority decision in which Managing Trustee's present must require with the permission of Hon'ble Charity Commissioner office.
